Present:- Complainant alongwith Sh. Sanjeev Gupta, Advocate.
Sh. Manmohan Sharma, Advocate (proxy counsel for Sh. Dinesh Madra,
Advocate) on behalf of respondent.

Counsels from both the parties came present. The counsel for complainant made a statement to the effect that the matter has been settled between both the parties and respondent has issued 4 cheques to the complainant & requested to withdraw this complaint at this stage, reserving the right of the complainant to get it revived, in case of dishonour of any of the cheques and further stated that the complaint may be disposed off accordingly.

The proxy counsel for the respondent has made a statement to the effect that the matter has been settled between the parties and the respondent has issued 4 cheques to the complainant as mentioned in the statement of the counsel, for the complainant, as full and final settlement. He has heard and understood the statement of counsel for the complainant, which is correct and stated that the matter may be disposed off accordingly.

In view of the above statements made by both the counsels, the complaint stands disposed off as withdrawn, with liberty to the complainant to get it revived in case the terms and conditions of the mutual settlement are not honoured. Further, the respondent shall be liable for a penalty of Rs.20,000/- per cheque, in case the same is dishonoured and in such situation the revived complaint would be decided in accordance with law. File be consigned to record room and copy of order be provided, free of cost, to both the complainant and the respondent.
