Today the complaint is fixed for ex-parte arguments. In the instant complaint the complainant seeks possession of a 3 BHK flat NO.3609 measuring 1400 square feet in E-35, Sunny Heights by claiming that he made full and final payments on different dates and further claims that no due certificate has been issue by the promoter Bajwa Developers. There is no receipt in regard to payment of amount and copy of the agreement on the record. At this stage, the complainant has suffered a statement that there are certain legal flaws in the complaint, therefore, he withdraws this complaint with permission to file a fresh complaint on the same cause of action and this complaint may be disposed of accordingly.
