

Respondent/JD is ex-parte vide Order dt. 20.04.2023

Mr. Manmohan Sharma Advocate has put in appearance today on behalf of the respondent/JD and sought adjournment for filing application for setting aside the ex-parte vide Order dt. 20.04.2023 and for filing his power of attorney.

This execution could not be decided within sixty days as per the guidelines of the Hon'ble Supreme Court primarily because the recovery warrant was issued on dt. 28.04.2023 and transmitted for execution to the District Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, SAS Nagar (Mohali) and despite issuance the reminder, the said authority failed to make the compliance.

Fresh reminder be issued to District Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, SAS Nagar (Mohali) for realisation of the due amount on the basis of recovery certificate on or before 03.10.2023. However, as the concerned revenue authority has not been able to comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Apex Court and it is further clarified by the Hon'ble High Court regarding completion of the proceedings of execution within 60 days from the date of filing; therefore, notice is required to be issued to the concerned Tehsildar through District Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, SAS Nagar (Mohali) for showing cause as to why the matter should not be referred to the Hon'ble High Court for initiating contempt proceedings because of the default of the concerned Tehsildar in deliberately not complying with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court as per the guidelines of the Hon'ble Apex Court and explanation by concerned Tehsildar be submitted on or before 03.10.2023. Copy of the reminder be also sent to the Tehsildar, RERA, Process be also sent through email.
