Case taken up today as 22.08.2018 was declared public holiday due to Id Festival. The complainant has filed an application for withdrawal of application in form-M. Copy supplied to the other side. Complainant has also made separate statement that he withdraws this complaint at this stage without prejudice to any of his right and with liberty to file a fresh complaint. The learned representative for respondent has also made a statement stating therein that no liberty may be granted to the complainant as another complaint filed by him seeking refund is pending. He has further stated that the complainant has filed two complaints simultaneously seeking contradictory prayers and the instant complaint be permitted to be withdrawn unconditionally.
