


Gurpreet Singh Vs. ACME

The representatives for the parties have stated that the parties have effected a compromise and Ms. Kashika Kaur, representative for the complainant has suffered a statement that she has been instructed by the complainant to state that the dispute between the parties has been amicably resolved vide agreement dated 17.05.2018 and the dispute has been fully and finally settled. She does not intend to pursue the instant complaint and she may be permitted to withdraw the complaint while reserving her right to institute a fresh complaint on the same cause of action in case the respondent does not honour its obligation under the above agreement. She has further stated that the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the agreement dated 17.05.2018.

 Shri Vinod Sahni representative for the respondent has suffered a statement that the parties have settled the matter amicably vide agreement dated 17.05.2018 and the respondent shall abide by the terms and conditions of the agreement failing which the complainant shall be at liberty to file fresh complaint on the same cause of action.

Surpreet & vs APMC

As the parties have effected a compromise, the complaint is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the complainant to file a fresh complaint on the same cause of action if the respondent does not comply with the terms and conditions of the agreement dated 17.05.2018.
