

This is in response to the recent observation – “**that the provided extended NOC is auto-generated and lacks a signature from the department**”, we would like to submit & clarify that the auto-generated copy aligns with the office order dated 14.09.23, bearing no. 329, issued by the PPCB Department. Enclosed herewith is a copy of the aforementioned office order for your kind perusal.

As outlined in the office order, the PPCB Department has officially adopted the practice of auto-generating renewals for consent to establish, alongside other necessary approvals.

It is further submitted that initially, the CTE from PPCB and EC were obtained in accordance with the original layout. However, due to the revision of the layout, the inventory has been changed. The process of revising the EC is time-consuming, and it is important to note that the CTE revision can only be done subsequent to the EC revision. This information has been duly communicated to the honorable authority. Consequently, we have requested to be granted RERA only in respect of inventory as per our original layout and NOCs from the relevant departments. That, we have also submitted our affidavit in this regard.

OFFICE ORDER

Subject: Auto generation of renewal of consent to establish / operate / authorization of any category of Small Scale industries / projects / Health Care Facilities (upto 50 beds) and Hazardous Waste generating industries.

In supersession of Board's office order no. 443 dated 09.08.2021 and no. 444 dated 10.08.2021, the Board has decided to facilitate the entrepreneurs with **"Auto generation of renewal of consent to establish / operate / authorization of any category of Small Scale industries / projects / Health Care Facilities (upto 50 beds) and Hazardous Waste generating industries"** on the basis of self-declaration by these entrepreneurs and shall be without any inspection / physical verification by the officers of the PPCB. The industry shall apply for Auto renewal with following stipulations:

1. Applicant shall file renewal application online.
2. The entrepreneurs shall submit the self-declaration form in the prescribed format enclosed as per Annexure-A.
3. The entrepreneurs shall deposit the consent renewal fee.
4. The validity of the Auto generated renewal shall be for a period as prescribed for the respective category of industries as per the policy of the Board.
5. In case, if any anomaly after Auto renewal is observed, that the entrepreneurs has submitted any false/ incorrect/ incomplete/forged facts and documents, the PPCB shall initiate appropriate action for violation under the Environmental Laws/ Rules against the industry.

This order will come in force with effect from 15.09.2023.
