When the matter was taken up for hearing today, learned counsel for the respondent drew the attention of the Bench to the settlement deed executed between the parties and submitted that the dispute has been amicably resolved. Accordingly, a request was made for disposal of the present complaint in light of the said settlement.

It is observed from the record that the complainant was absent on the previous date of hearing as well, despite having been granted a final opportunity to file a response to the respondent's application concerning the settlement and to appear before the Bench. However, the complainant has once again failed to appear or file any response.

In view of the mutual settlement between the parties and the continued absence of the complainant, the present complaint stands dismissed in default, it being amicably settled.

It is clarified that this dismissal is solely on account of the reported settlement and the non-prosecution of the matter, and is **without prejudice to the merits of the case**. The complainant shall, however, be at liberty to file a fresh complaint, in the event if the settlement deed was not entered with the respondent and/or there were valid reasons for non-attendance. The file be consigned to the record room.
